Looking for a small group activity in the Metro Detroit area? I read recently about not one, but two new options.

[Inside Detroit Tours & Outings](#) is now offering Segway tours of the city. "We have public Segway Tours on Saturdays at 10:00 a.m. and now Mondays at 5:00 p.m.," says Inside Detroit co-founder Jeanette Pierce. "We'll offer them until the end of October, and you can book them right off our website. Private groups can book at anytime for \$450 for up to 6 people." Side note: Jeanette is an encyclopedia of Detroit history and loves sharing that knowledge.

You'll have to do the other tour using foot power, but owner Ann Wilson makes it worth the effort—and you'll welcome the chance to burn a few calories. [Culinary Escapes](#) gives a unique twist to the foodie tour by incorporating multiple stops and behind-the-scenes encounters. "You not only get to sample a variety of food, you get to meet the people (chefs) behind the food," says Wilson. Three-hour private tours can be booked for groups of up to 40 and are currently offered in Birmingham and Royal Oak; Ferndale and Detroit tours are coming soon.
